

Rhino Heavy Duty - Gutter Mount

Place these instructions in the vehicle's glove box after installation is complete.

Important: Please read these instructions carefully prior to installation.

Please refer to your fitting instruction to ensure that the roof racks are installed in the

correct locations.

Check the contents of kit before commencing fitment and report any discrepancies.

Care Instruction

Wash and clean vehicle roof prior to fitting the Rhino Heavy Duty roof racks.


Tools Required


5/8" Spanner

Rubber mallet

Security type allen key, provided in kit


Tape measure






Loosen leg clamp screws. Install the rubber boot.






Install crossbar onto legs. Position legs at ends of crossbar. Push the leg attachment bolt up and turn the bolt so that the channel nut is fully located across the crossbar. Finger tighten attachment bolt as the legs will require adjustment when placed onto the vehicle.



Place the crossbar and leg assembly onto the roof.




Adjust the legs so that the foot of the legs sits into the corner of the gutter. Ensure the crossbar overhang is equal on both sides. Re-adjust if required.




Hold the leg against the gutter corner and tighten the crossbar attachment bolt with 5/8" spanner to 4-5Nm. **Do not over tighten.** Check the channel nut is fully located across the crossbar after tightening. Rotate the clamp under the roof gutter lip, the clamp must be fully located into the corner of the gutter lip. Finger tighten clamp screws.






Progressively tighten lower clamp screws to secure the roof rack to the gutter. Repeat the tightening process on the other side of the vehicle. Tighten security bolts to 3-4Nm.



Insert the end caps and rubber buffer into the crossbar using a rubber mallet. Check all attachment bolts and screws after fitment.



Important Information

RECOMMENDATIONS

Please refer to your vehicle manufacturers operating manual for maximum roof load rating.

It is essential that all bolt connections be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your Rhino Heavy Duty Crossbars.

Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (probably once a week is enough, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the roof bars each time they are refitted.

Crossbars and accessories should be cleaned and all screw threads should be lubricated at regular intervals.

Rhino-Rack offers a 3 year warranty to the original purchaser of the Rhino Heavy Duty roof rack system and Accessories.

Rhino-Rack cannot be held responsible for incorrect mounting of the roof rack system or for usage that exceeds vehicle and production tolerances.

Make sure to fasten your load securely.

Please ensure that all loads are evenly distributed and that the centre of gravity is kept as low as possible.

USE ONLY NON-STRETCH FASTENING ROPES OR STRAPS.

SENSITIVITY TO CROSSWINDS, BEHAVIOUR IN CURVES AND BRAKING

The handling characteristics of the vehicle change when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons, we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resisting loads; special consideration must be taken into account when braking.

PLEASE REMOVE CROSSBARS WHEN PUTTING VEHICLE THROUGH AN AUTOMATIC CAR WASH

LOAD RATINGS

The vehicle manufactures recommended load rating is the maximum permissible load per pair of roof racks (include the weight of the roof rack, 5kg). When roof bars are to be used in extreme off-road conditions please build a safety factor of 1.5 into this maximum load limit. Although roof bars are tested and approved to AS1235-2000, Australian road conditions can be much more rigorous.
